

Jiro

It is very popular among tourists. There are (**)some reasons for this. The building is traditional and beautiful. The guest rooms are unique. The large bathrooms are new and clean. Many people go there to take a bath and enjoy it very much. I went to Okayama with my family last winter. We stayed at the hotel and had a good time. I want to visit it again.

Miho

I learned about a bookstore café in Kyoto on the Internet. It is very interesting. It was an old factory before. ((1)) The building is more than 100 years old. About ten years ago, it was renovated as a bookstore café. Look at these pictures (5) take in the café. It has mud walls and earth floors. In the café, there is a lot of old furniture like tables and chairs. They are wonderful. It is very quiet, and time goes slowly there. I'm sure you can relax and enjoy reading books.
